In memory of Rev.Fr.Sarathjeevan who was martyred for his people in the last days of the Sri Lankan civil war, Fr. Sarathjeevan Foundation was established by the members of his family in the year 2013. Initially the Foundation supported six students in the Uruthirapuram Parish of the Kilinochchi district, by providing each of them Rs.1,000 monthly. The Foundation started to function officially from June 10, 2014, with the patronage of the Bishop Emeritus of Jaffna, Rt. Rev.Dr. E. Thomas Sovundaranayagam, and the present Bishop, Rt. Rev. Dr.JustinB.Gnanaparagasam. The five member Board has Rev. Fr. C. G. Jeyakumar as the Director, Rev. Fr. S. Jude Amalathas as the Treasurer, Ms. NithilaMariampillai as the Secretary, Rev. Fr. T.J.Kirupaharan and Ms. NicolineSaminathar.

With the benevolent donations from the multi-national contributors, the Foundation is now supporting ninety two students on a monthly basis for their education. Students are selected basing on their interest in education, while being the victims of the civil war, and living under the poverty-line. These deserving students are from Uruthirapuram, Iranaippaalai, Kumulamunai, Mullaiththeevu, Poonakary, Kokilai, Atchuveli and Jaffna parishes. The Foundation is also helping the poor who are disabled in the civil war.

We thank our donors and the Reverend Fathers who are supporting the Foundation.

Livelihood Assistance

Fr. Sarathjeevan Foundation has donated Rs. 50,000.00 for two families at Udayarkaddu for goat-rearing and poultry on the 10th of January 2018. Mr. Vadivel, UK, and Mrs. Suganthy Family, Canada, donated this fund for the LVH assistance.

Fr. Sarathjeevan Foundation supported Mrs. Chandrabavan Jasmin Hilda in Puththur to put up a small shop for her livelihood on 3rd July 2019. Mr. Christopher Family donated Rs. 25,000.00 for this assistance. We sincerely thank the family.

Rs. 30,765.00 worth stationery were provided to the Social Service Group of St. James' Church, Vasavilan, to put up a Small stationery shop on 10.10.2019. Mr. Vadivel, UK, donated this fund. We thank him.



Bicycles for the students



Fr. Sarathjevan Foundation supported three students at Atchuvely and one student at Anaikoddai by providing bicycles to them in March and October 2018. Mr. Anjalo, Atchuvely, Fr. Jeban, CR, Atchuvely, and Mr. Vadivel, UK, donated funds for the bicycles.

Another bicycle was donated to a G.C.E.(A/L) student from Kokilai in December 2018 at the cost of Rs.18,000/-. He was studying at Semmalai School, travelling everyday from Kokilai. The fund was donated by Mr. Christy Arul Mariampillai, France, through 'Christy Oorani Development Project'. We express our gratitude to him.

Exercise books for the poor children

Exercise books were given to the children from poor families on 12th January 2018. Dr. Mrs. Ratnakumary Pushparajah Family has donated Rs. 40,000.00 for this support. 43 children were selected by the Jaffna District Secretariat. Revd. Fr. C. G. Jeyakumar handed over the exercise books to the children.

Medical Assistance

Sanitary items worth Rs. 30,000.00 were given to a differently abled person in Atchuveli on 17th March 2018. Rs. 25,000.00 was given to a cancer-patient at Navanthurai on 1st September 2018. Mr. Vadivel, UK, donated the funds for the medical assistance.

Medical Assistance worth Rs. 40,000.00 was given to Mr. V. Victor Dominic, in Pandeteruppu on 12th June 2019 for his heart-surgery. Mr. Vadivel, UK, donated the funds for the medical assistance.

Three children in the family of Mrs. Kavitha Sivakumar are suffering from the failure of kidney. Rs. 30,000.00 was given to the family as Medical Assistance in October, November and December, 2019. Mr. Vadivel, UK, donated the funds for the medical assistance.

Educational Assistance

Fr. Sarathjeevan Foundation has been supporting monthly 92war-affected and poor students for their education. One child from the Thuriyappa Vidyalayam, Columbuthurai, receives educational support since September 2019. She lost both parents. She is presently living with her grandparents. Ms. P.J.P. Ashap, Jaffna, supports this child.

Eleven children from the war-affected families, living in Mallavi and the Mullaitivu District have been receiving Educational Assistance since September 2018. Mr. S. Ganeshkumar, UK, supports 10 children, and Mrs. Thankamalar Rasa, living in Anaikoddai, supports one child. Monthly allowances for these students are being given through Rev. Fr. S. Skaranraj, the Parish Priest, St. Sebastian's Church, Mallavi.

In October 2018, Mr. Justin Jesurajah and Mrs. Anjana Justin started assisting 10 children in the Naranthanai village. These students are studying at RC School, Naranthanai, and the financial support for these children's education are being given through Rev. Fr. A. Mac Mayooran.

Further, 71 students from Uruthirapuram, Iranaipalai, Kumulamunai, Mullaithivu, Kokilai, Jaffna, Delft, Poonakary, Columbuthurai and Atchuvely also receive Educational Assistance. Monthly allowance for these children is given through Rev. Frs. S. Jude Amalathas, P. Renald Cherilnes (Suman), J. A. Arulthasan, M. Shoban Rufus, A. Alwin Kirubakaran, Confusious OMI, A. Mac Mayooran and Mr. V. Ameelton. Dr. J. C. P. Rajendra, Dr. Jaiman Emmanuel (Australia), Dr. Mrs. P. Ratnakumary (UK), Mr & Mrs. Logan



and Marie (USA), Mr. Vadivel (UK), Mr & Mrs Justin and Anjana (UK), Mr. Ganeshkumar (UK), Mr. Sanjeeva

Lokuge, The Christopher Family, Mr. Fenton Alphonse, Mr. Christy Arul (Urani Foundation, France) and Ms. Nithila Mariampillai have been giving financial support to these students. Three students have been assisted from the interest earned from the FSF Fixed Deposit. In general, the students of Grade 5 or above were selected, and, monthly allowance of Rs.1000.00 was given to each student.

In December 2018, Mr.Christy Arul Mariampillai, France, donated Rs. 500,000.00 to open a Fixed Deposit in order to support the children for their education. The interest earned from this FD will be utilized to support 5 children in the Kokillai village in the Mullaithivu district.

Fr. Sarathjeevan Foundation has taken initiatives to support the children of Ilupaikadavai in the Diocese of Mannar from the year 2020. In December 2019, Mr. Christy Arul, France, donated Rs. 650,000.00 from the Urany Foundation to open a Fixed Deposit Account. Five children will be selected from Ilupaikadavai in consultation with the Parish Priest of Ilupaikadavai. The educational support for these children will be given from January 2020.

Construction of house
